


Cut around the ring sizer and make a slit where the line is.

Make a loose circle by slipping the end through the slit and place the finger you need measure through it and tighten.

To get an accurate reading we recommend ensuring that your fingers are warm and you carry out the measurement towards the end of the day.



Take an existing ring that fits the finger you are looking for. Place it on the outlines below to determine the correct size. The right size will be when the edge of the circle touches the inside of the ring all the way round. If your ring sits between two sizes we recommend to take the bigger size.



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
